Based at the SBF Academy in Macclesfield, this role blends hands-on workshop experience with structured academic learning, supporting the day-to-day operations of the workshop while progressing toward an IMI Level 3 Motorcycle Technician qualification. You will bring passion and ownership to your work, contributing to a positive, innovative, and supportive environment where both colleagues and bikers feel at home.

Key Responsibilities

1. Lead with Passion:

- Approach all workshop tasks with a positive, can-do attitude and enthusiasm for learning
- Demonstrate pride in delivering quality repairs, inspections, and motorcycle care
- Maintain a clean, safe, and well-organised workspace at all times

2. Innovate Continuously:

- Take part in technical development opportunities, including installation of tracking systems and use of diagnostic equipment
- Embrace new technologies and methods taught during training and adapt them into practical work

3. Own Your Work:



- Complete Internal and Exit Pre-Delivery Inspections (PDIs) under supervision
- Undertake remedial and upsell servicing on stock and sold bikes
- Accurately complete workshop documentation and follow company processes

4. Collaborate as a Team:

- Assist technicians and team members in daily workshop operations
- Attend regular college days with EMTEC training partners and participate in group learning sessions
- Support wider workshop cleanliness and team effectiveness

5. Support Learning:

- Progress through the IMI Level 3 Motorcycle Technician qualification
- Remain on track with coursework deadlines, both practical and theory-based
- Seek feedback and coaching to improve technical performance and academic outcomes

Required Skills and Qualifications

Essential:

- GCSEs in English & Maths at Grade C/4 or above (or equivalent)
- Basic IT proficiency, including Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook and Teams
- Strong attention to detail, reliability, and organisational skills
- Willingness to learn and motivation to progress through the apprenticeship programme

Desirable:

- Full or restricted motorcycle licence
- Hands-on mechanical or technical experience
- Familiarity with tools, engineering principles or vehicle diagnostics (e.g., TEXA)

- Demonstrate steady academic and practical progress aligned to the training plan
- Complete workshop tasks to a high standard and within agreed timeframes
- Maintain compliance with Health & Safety and workshop cleanliness policies
- Deliver accurate and timely completion of logbooks, assignments, and workplace documentation

- Environment: Workshop-based with classroom sessions held on site
- Physical Requirements: Manual handling, standing for extended periods, movement of motorcycles
- Schedule: 38.75 hours per week (on-site), including college learning hours
